[Correct answer: tomorrow / adverb of time. The adverb indicates when the parents will arrive.]

Respuesta correcta: **on the tallest mountain / adverb of place**. El adverbio indica dónde esquiaron.

[Correct answer: on the tallest mountain / adverb of place. The adverb indicates where they skied.]

Pregunta n°7

Respuesta correcta: **into the rabbit hole / adverb of place**. El adverbio indica dónde cayó Alice.

[Correct answer: into the rabbit hole / adverb of place. The adverb indicates where Alice fell.]

Pregunta n°8

Respuesta correcta: **all week / adverb of time**. El adverbio indica cuándo se espera la lluvia.

[Correct answer: all week / adverb of time. The adverb indicates when the rain is expected.]

Respuesta correcta: **menacingly / adverb of manner**. El adverbio indica cómo gruñó el oso.
*[Correct answer: **menacingly / adverb of manner**. The adverb indicates how the bear growled.]*

Respuesta correcta: **quickly / adverb of manner**. El adverbio indica cómo el capitán abordó el bote.
*[Correct answer: **quickly / adverb of manner**. The adverb indicates how the captain boarded the boat.]*

[Correct answer: quickly – easily / adverb of manner. The adverb indicates how the boys ran and jumped the fence.]

Respuesta correcta: **encouragingly / adverb of manner**. El adverbio indica cómo sonrió la profesora a sus estudiantes.
[Correct answer: encouragingly / adverb of manner. The adverb indicates how the teacher smiled at her students.]

ITEM 3

> Para convertir un adjetivo en adverbio se debe agregar "ly" al final del adjetivo.

> Si el adjetivo termina en "y", se cambia la "y" por "i" y se agrega "ly" al final del adjetivo.

[> To turn an adjective into an adverb you have to add "ly" at the end of the adjective.

> If the adjective ends with "y", you have to change the "y" into an "i" and add "ly" at the end of the adjective.]
